



Our History & Accomplishments

The Woodland Library Rose Club was founded in 1989 by a handful of hardworking and dedicated individuals with a vision. Their goal was to create and maintain a beautiful rose garden area surrounding Woodland's historic Carnegie Library. In 1991 the Memorial Rose Garden was dedicated. The Perimeter Wall Garden was dedicated on April 25th, 1992. In cooperation with the City of Woodland, the Woodland Library Rose Club extended the gardens of the Library to the north and west with the John A Saltsman Garden, dedicated on September 26th, 1998.

The Club boasts three American Rose Society Rosarians happy to share their knowledge and love of roses.

In June 2015, the Club's gardens received the prestigious "Award of Garden Excellence" from the World Federation of Rose Societies.
