

Woodland Library Rose Club Scholarship

The Woodland Library Rose Club founded in 1989, maintains three significant rose gardens located on the Woodland Library grounds.

Scholarship Information

1. This scholarship is for one year. Students are eligible to receive a Woodland Library Rose Club scholarship a maximum of two times.
2. All scholarship money will be mailed to the Registrars of the respective college, university or trade school to be dispersed to the student one-half of the total at the beginning of the academic year and one half at the beginning of the second semester.
3. The Woodland Library Rose Club Board of Directors will determine the number of scholarships and amount of the scholarships to be awarded each year based on the funds available.
4. Written applications must be submitted by March 31, 2019 (postmarked).
5. Selections will be made by the Woodland Library Rose Club Scholarship Committee. All applicants will be notified by letter of their outcome.
6. Results will be announced in May.
7. If the recipient drops out of school, the balance of the money will be returned to the Woodland Library Rose Club.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be related to a Woodland Library Rose Club member who has been in good standing for at least two years.
2. Applicant must reside in Yolo County.
3. Applicant must be a graduating senior of a California High School with a current 3.0 grade point average or an enrolled Trade School, Junior College or College student with a current 2.75 grade point average. Transcript of grade records must accompany the application of a graduating senior. A copy documenting the grade point average must accompany all other applications.
4. Applicant must be accepted at a college, junior college, or trade school. Copy of acceptance must accompany application.
5. Selection of scholarship recipients will be based on: academic record; participation in extra-curricular activities; moral character; and relationship to a current member of the Woodland Library Rose Club.
